# About Tanzania

- Population: 57,000,000
- One of the poorest countries in the world
- Subsistence farming employs 85% work force
- 25M lack access to clean water
- 40M lack access to improved sanitation

Most of Tanzania has a climate classified as 'tropical savannah' with two short wet seasons – the rest of the time water is scarce.

The most reliable source of water is from artesian bores.

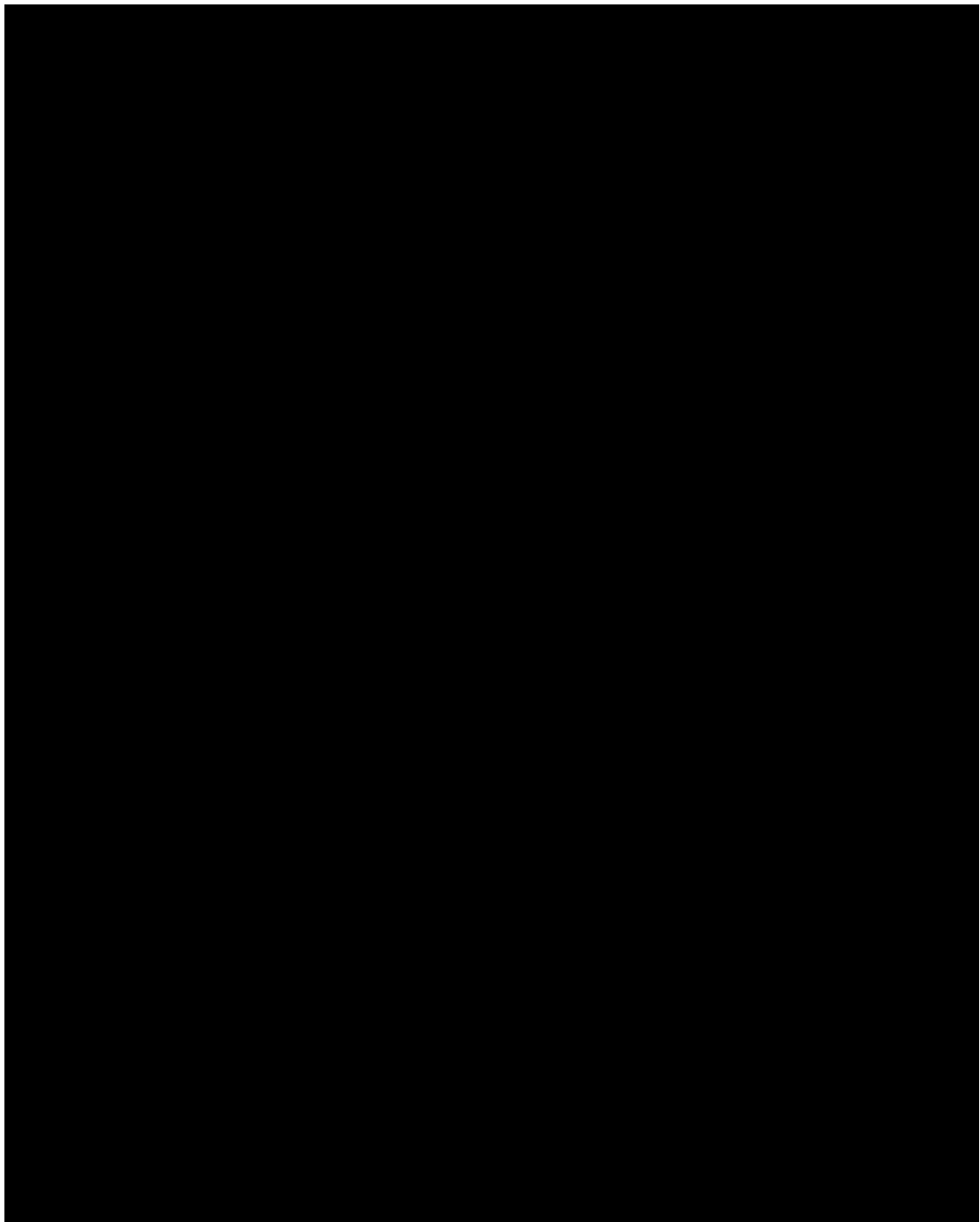
Children spend a lot of time collecting water at the expense of attending school



Access to water in Tarime District is poor and of poor quality.

The Peter Hewitt Care for Africa Foundation – a Tasmanian based charity has installed 12 water bores since 2007 mostly nears schools





The last bore to be installed was at Bulimba in 2020 and funded by members of Launceston Rotary Clubs

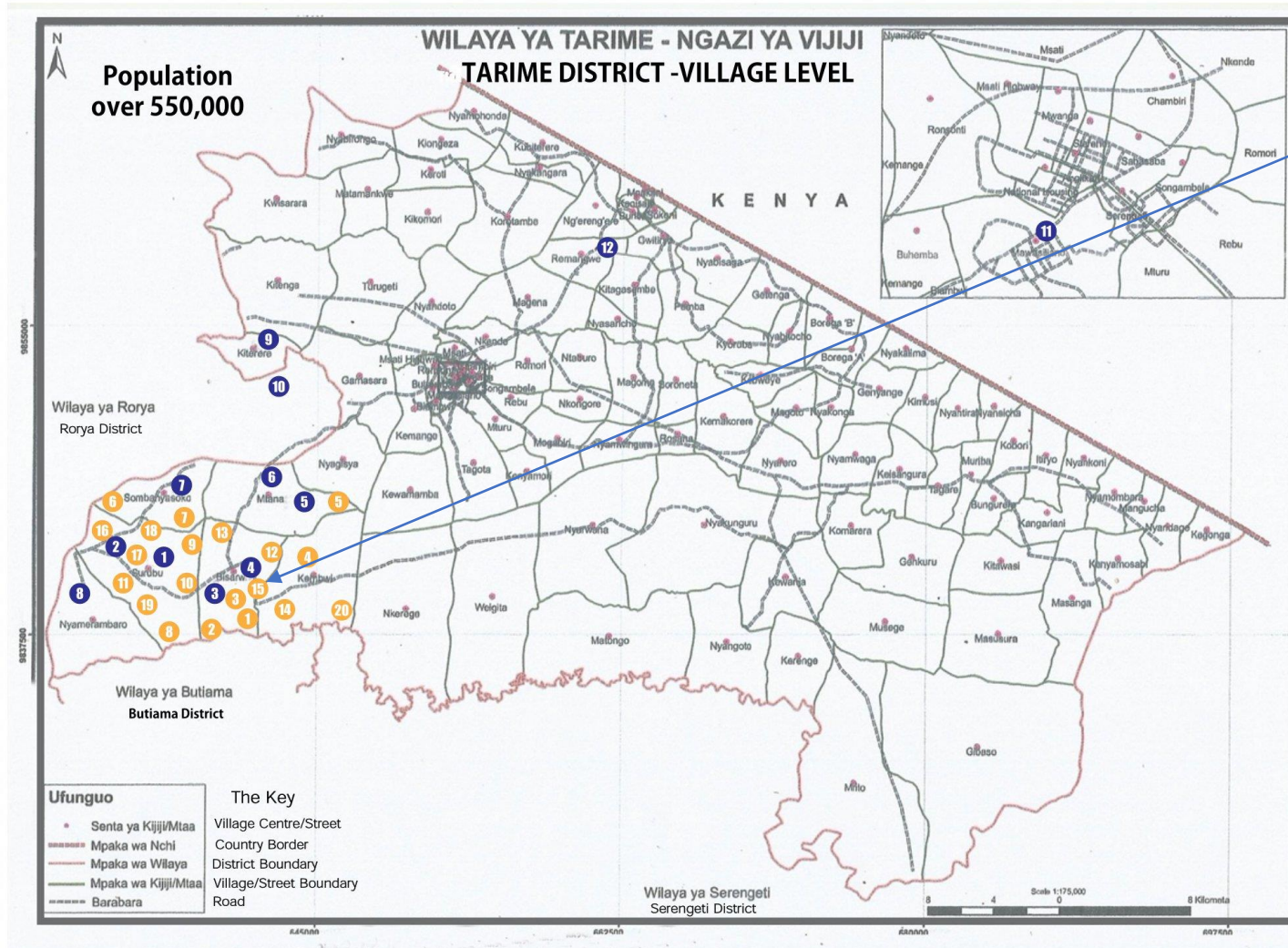


The plan is to complete 10-20 bores at a cost of \$US120,000 – 200,000

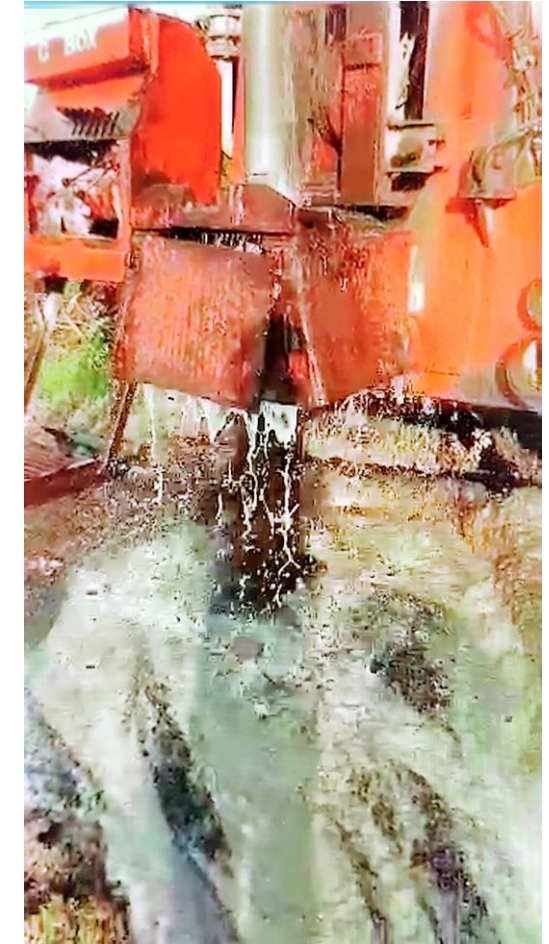
Rotarian Abdallah Obedi identified 20 potential sites in South West Tarime District and completed a community needs survey.

## Four Bores have so far been installed

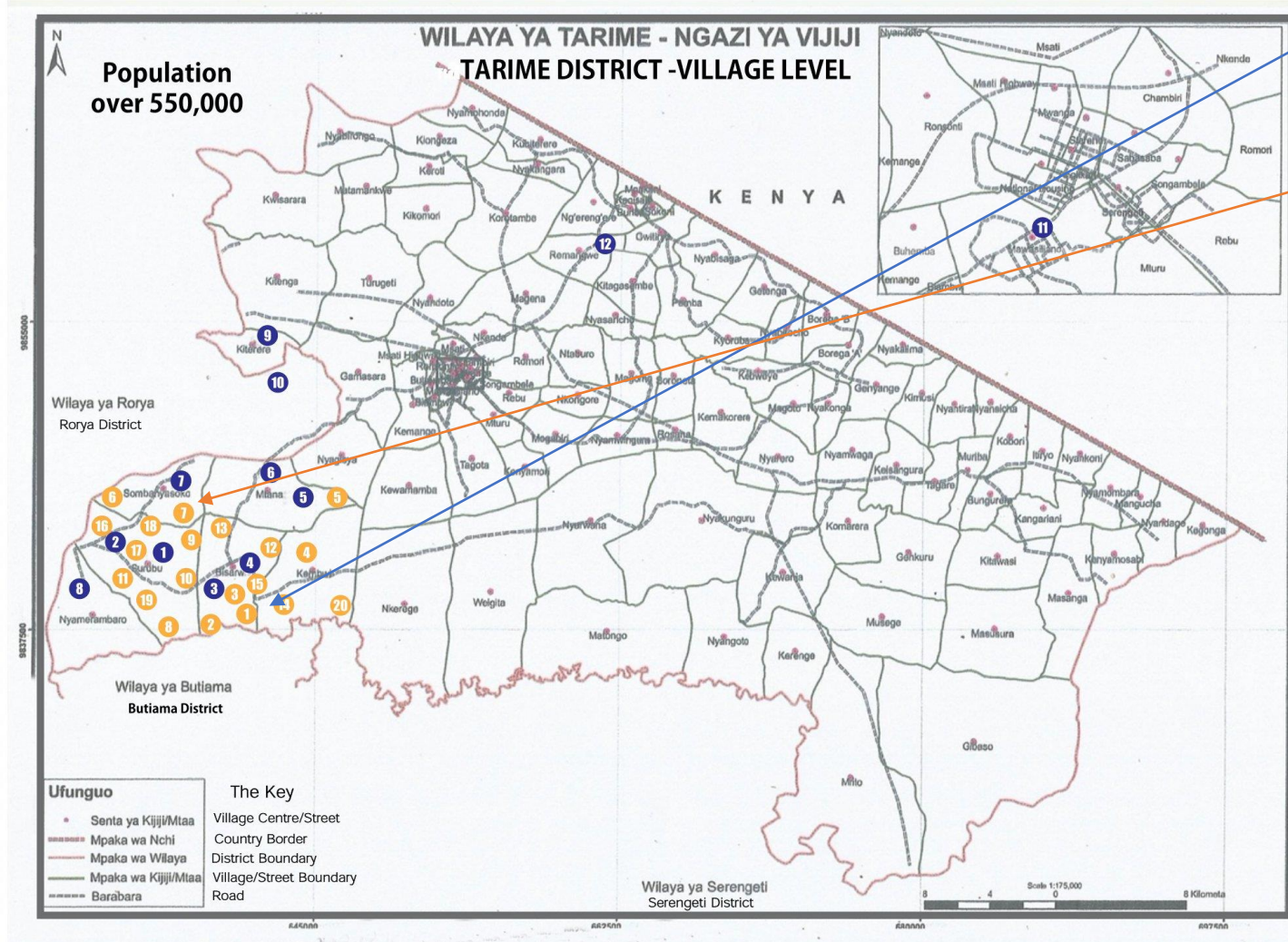
Bore number one installed 09-02-2023 Nyamatanke Site



● CURRENT WATER WELLS 1-12    ● 20 NEW WATER WELLS TO DRILL



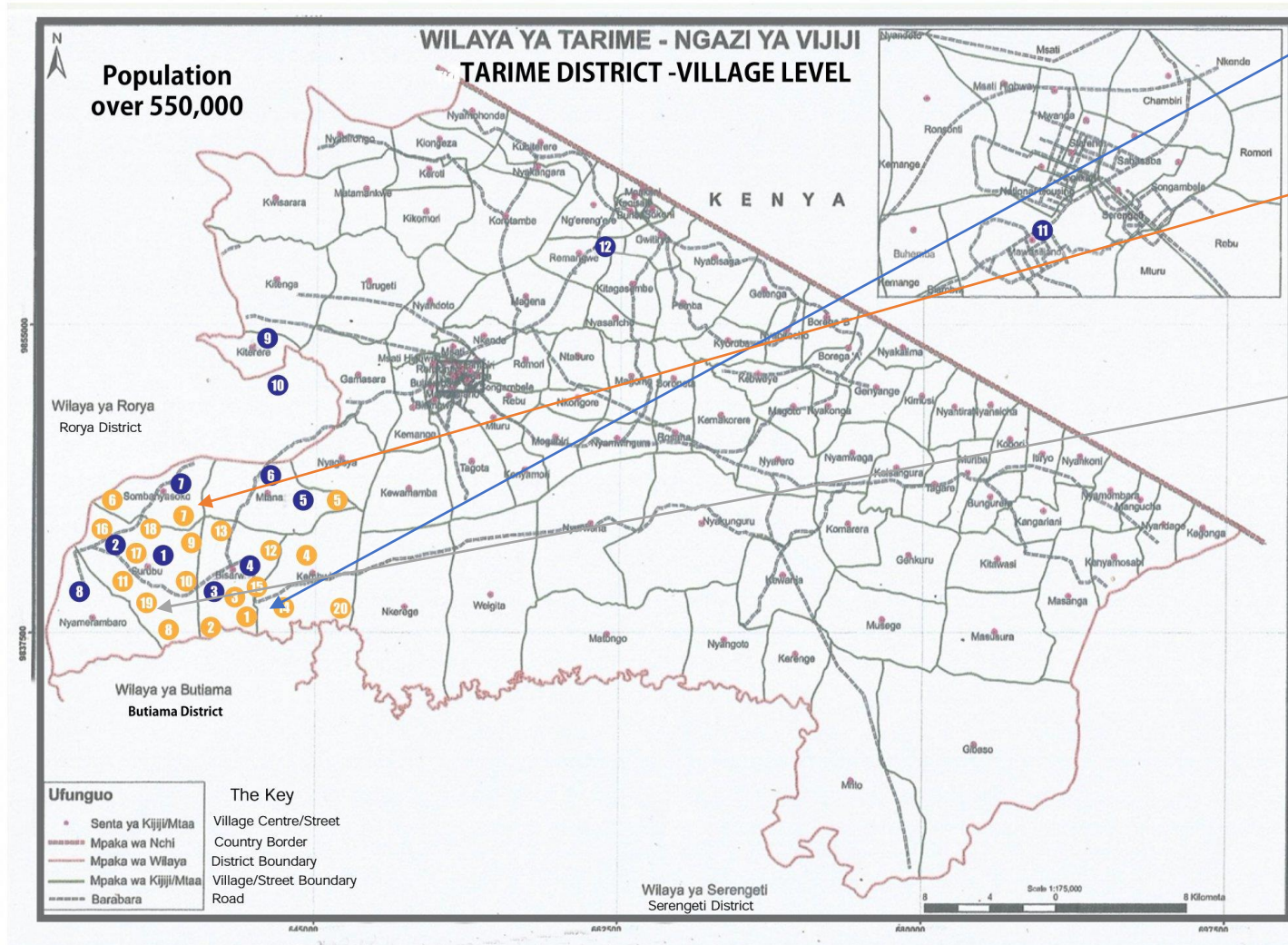

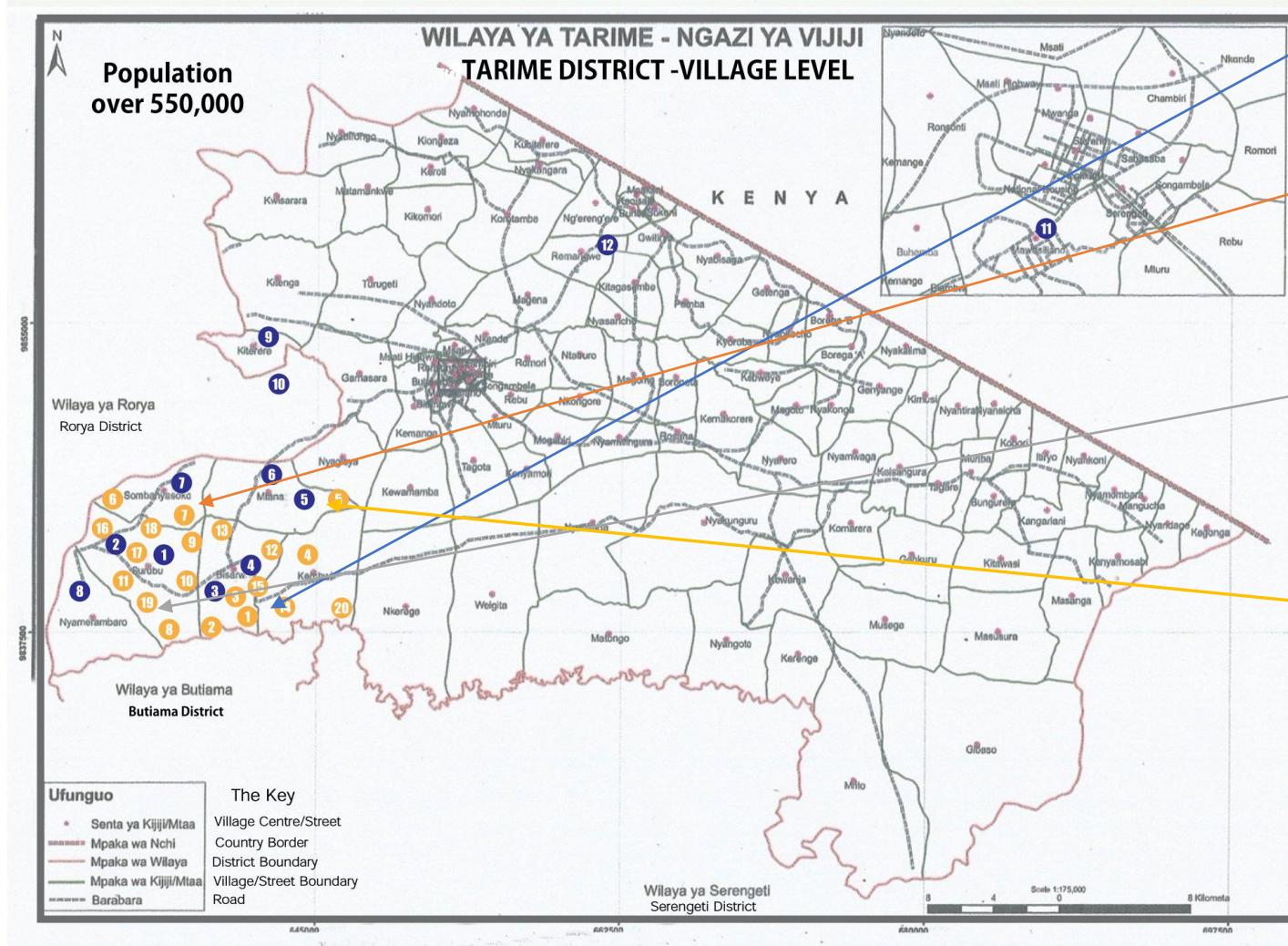

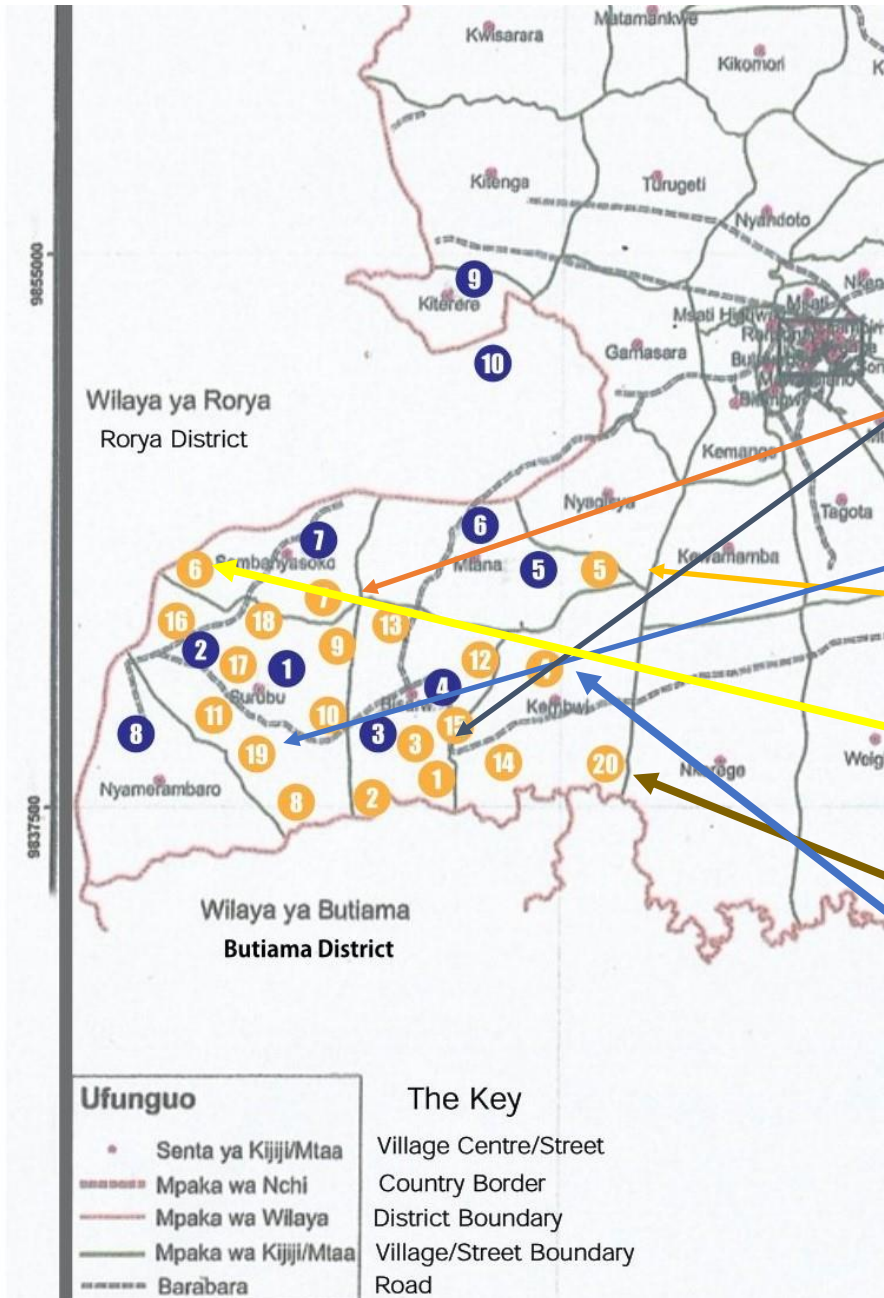
