








### Water Bores for Tanzania




Summary: Project aiming to install up to 20 water bores in Tarime, Tanzania, bringing water to up to 50,000 people. This grant application is sponsored by the Rotary Club of Central Launceston, as well as the Rotary Club of South Launceston. The project is hosted by the Rotary Club of Igoma, Mwanza, Tanzania. Cooperating organisations, The Peter Hewitt Care for Africa Foundation and RUWASA(Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Agency)

Challenge: Access to clean drinking water is the most basic human right. The women and children, especially the girls will walk up to 8 kms daily to collect water. This hinders the children's educational opportunities, increases the health burden and severely impacts on economic development.

Solution:

To provide clean accessible drinking water for the people in the Tarime District.

Four bores installed to date





Three more underway - help fund the eighth bore by donating below

Long term impact: The alleviation of poverty through giving health, educational and enterprise opportunities.
