Challenge:

Access to clean drinking water is the most basic human right. The women and children, especially the girls will walk up to 8 kms daily to collect water. This hinders the children’s educational opportunities, increases the health burden and severely impacts on economic development.

Solution:

To provide clean accessible drinking water for the people in the Tarime District.

Four bores installed to date.

Three more underway – help fund the eighth bore by donating below

1. Nyamatanke Village
2. Nyabhanosi Village
3. Nyangoge Village
4. Makora Village 2



Long term impact:

The alleviation of poverty through giving health, educational and enterprise opportunities.
