

THE CHARITY STORY

A timeline of our history

2008

- Horrific post-election violence, in 2008.
- Growing number of street children
- Centre was set up in Langalanga,
- Modest property to give initial shelter to just six boys, providing refuge for those

2009

- UK Trust was created in November 2009
- by Ted Maidment, who led the Trust until July 2015.
- Ted played a key role in building up supporters and donors, allowing Restart grow in Kenya.
- Sanata Womens Group (SWG) was formed
- Restart community projects
- Aims to improve circumstances for women in the Gilgil area
- Provides work which makes use of their fine needlework and artistic skills.
- Charity provides training, materials and equipment
- Women are paid in return for their work

2013

- Number of children swelled to over 100
- Ages ranging from just a few months old to youths in their late teens
- Original buildings were in a poor state
- Desperate need to house all the children
- Building of the new Restart premises began
- Funded through donations

2014

- Children moved into the new Centre
- Spend first Christmas in new home.
- Safe and healthy environment for kids to grow up.
- Dedicated onsite staff keep the orphanage running
- Social worker, teachers, cooks, nursery staff, cleaners, and security staff.

2015

- Orphanage officially opened in April
- Opening by the British High Commissioner, Dr Christian Turner,
- Several hundred special guests, friends, and government officials.

THE SITUATION

- Hand to mouth existence on the streets
- Severe, often sexual, abuse and deprivation
- Significant emotional issues
- It takes many months of love and care
- Want to provide a more settled life in the Centre

OUR AIMS

To rescue desperate homeless children from the streets of Kenya, where drugs, violence and prostitution are rife.

To provide these children with a home, education, care and counselling.

To uplift and empower the community by providing work opportunities.

- Trying to tackle the causes of child abuse
- Supporting a number of local initiatives to help employ and empower the community.

Projects:

- Briquette making operation
- Women's craft group
- Agricultural plot supplying vegetables the Centre & Village
- Herb garden that produces holistic medicinal treatments.
- Provide employment for more than 90 adults
- Employ former children from the orphanage
- No grants or funding from the Kenyan government
- Centre supported by donations & sponsorship.

SANATA WOMEN'S GROUP

- Aims to empower the women in Gilgil
- Improve circumstances by providing work
- Fine needlework & artistic skills.
- Charity provides training, materials & equipment
- Payment for work that they do
- Sale via Restart Africa Australia Online Shop




MEDICINAL HERBS

- Beautiful garden filled with over 800 different African herbs
- Made into therapeutic teas or capsules
- Shipped to our partner, Healthy U
- Supply our own clinic in Gilgil.
- Provides employment and selfrespect for members of the local community

AGRI PROJECT

- Own farm
- Provides fresh vegetables for children at the Restart Centre
- Surplus supplies sold to local community.
- Workers are provided with employment, money, training, self-respect & vitamin-packed veg!



RESTART BRIQUETTES

- Recycling waste materials into fuel briquettes
- Eco-friendly substitute for burning charcoal
- Cheap to make and completely smokeless
- Project was initially manned by 7 former Restart boys and boys from the streets.
- Formed youth group
- Restart pays for briquettes,

RESTART AFRICA AUSTRALIA

- Support Network in Australia
- Formation of dedicated volunteers
- Supporting mother organisation in Kenya
- Mission to provide a safe and healthy environment for all Restart kids away from drugs, abuse, violence and homelessness.
- Led by National Convenor Peter Maynard
- Growing support network in Australia
- Mobilise people to join the Restart family

FOCUS POINTS:

- Fundraising
- Volunteer Engagement
- Sponsorships for all children (main support component)

Currently 13 kids are sponsored by Australian supporters.






RESTART AFRICA AUSTRALIA



- Nationally recognised Rotary charity in Australia
- Sponsored by The Rotary Club of West Tamar in Tasmania
- Rotary formed to assist disadvantaged communities and individuals
- Rotary Australia World Community Service (RAWCS)
- Provides financial infrastructure system to facilitate fundraising
- Delivers humanitarian aid and charitable support in Australia and overseas.

- Being a Rotary project give us an official charity status
- Saves us 80% of the transfer fees compared to banks
- More funds go directly to the Restart children
- 2.75% of all contributions go to RAWCS for transferring
- 97.25% go to the charity for children's care, staffing requirements etc.






ROTARY COMMUNITY SHOP in Beauty Point, Tasmania
