### IMAGINE...


- Not being able to turn on a tap for drinking, washing, cooking, parental care, or hygiene.
- Not knowing whether you will have water today for even the basics of life.
- Living with constant illnesses: diarrhea, cholera, typhoid, dysentery, Hepatitis A.
- Walking 8-12 km every day, spending 2-3 hours carrying 20 kg, totaling over 100 kg daily.
- Running from elephants while carrying water – because survival leaves no other choice.

### WHY THIS PROJECT MATTERS?

Clean water becomes the catalyst for transformation:

- Women and children reclaim 1,000+ hours every week previously lost to collecting water.
- Safer, healthier communities with fewer waterborne illnesses.
- Reliable water strengthens food security and household income.
- Wildlife gains safe access to water, reducing human-wildlife conflict.

### THE PLAN: PROJECT BUDGET BREAKDOWN

1. 100-metre borehole drilling - AUD \$7,827
2. Pump, plumbing & gravity-fed system delivering water to four manyattas + shared livestock/wildlife trough - AUD \$37,109
3. Protective measures: fully electrified fence guarding borehole and tanks from elephants - AUD \$14,279
4. Solar pumping system supplying water to four villages + two elevated holding tanks - AUD \$19,373
5. VAT (16%) - AUD \$12,573

TOTAL ESTIMATE (incl. 10% contingency): AUD \$99,157
